



Methods of Contributing to Y's Men International's Endowment Fund

1. **Contribution and a Tribute.** A Club, individual or group may make a US\$ 100 or more contribution and a tribute which will be edited and entered into the Golden Book in Geneva, Switzerland. Copies will be available for the Simulated Golden Books of each Area and Region. Tributes will be printed on golden-bordered pages and given to the person honored. You may honor: an individual with a living tribute or a memorial, an event, a club, etc.
2. A club, individual, convention, conference, event, etc. may make a contribution to the Endowment Fund and be listed on a special page.
3. **Paul William Alexander Fellow.** A person may contribute US\$ 100 or more (or US\$ 100 or more may be contributed on his/her behalf) and be listed on the special Paul William Alexander Fellow page in the Golden Book. A **certificate** and a **pin** will be sent to the RD or RSD to be handed to the PWA Fellow at a Y's Men function.
4. **Honor Roll Member.** When an individual contributes US\$ 1,000 or more or includes the Endowment Fund with an amount of US\$ 1,000 or more in his/her will, trust fund, insurance, stocks, bonds, etc. and notifies the Endowment ISD and IHQ in writing of this, that individual will be listed on the Honor Roll Member page in the Golden Book. (If requested, a husband and wife will be listed for a US\$ 1,000 contribution.) An **Iceberg Memento** will be given to Honor Roll Members to proudly display in their home or office. A **pin** will be given to be worn with pride. When someone contributes US\$ 1,000 again his/her name is listed with an asterisk and the words 2nd, 3rd, 4th, etc. contribution behind the name.
5. **Honor Roll Club.** When a club contributes US\$ 1,000 or more to the Endowment Fund it will be listed on the Honor Roll Club page in the Golden Book. An **Iceberg Memento** will be given to the Honor Roll Club.
6. **Endowment Friend.** An individual may contribute US\$ 50 or more to the Endowment Fund and be listed on the Endowment Friend page in the Golden Book. A new listing begins each year. This is not a once-only contribution such as the Paul William Alexander Fellow. We encourage yearly contributions.

We suggest that clubs include the Endowment Fund in their budget each year.

Each Area has its own uniqueness for contributions by Y's Men and Women to the Endowment Fund. Use whatever way works best for your Area. If you have any suggestions, please share them with RSD/ASD/ISD Endowment Fund Promotion or with me.
