Detailed Reporting

What were the goals for the reporting period?

Identify and mobilize 300 beneficiaries, training on restoration activities and provision of saplings such as (Cocoa, Coffee, Neem and pear to plant)

What goals were accomplished for the reporting period?

Identification and Mobilization of 300 beneficiaries on Environmental Restoration for Adaptation Project (ERAP) activities.

Training on restoration activities and tree planting.

Provision and planting of 600 fruit trees (Pear , cocoa, nem and coffee)

What were the problems and/or setbacks encountered for the reporting period?

During the two-month reporting period for the Environmental Restoration for Adaptation project, we encountered several challenges and setbacks. Firstly, inclement weather conditions, such as heavy rains and storms, hindered our field activities and delayed progress. Secondly, we faced logistical issues, including transportation constraints and limited availability of necessary equipment and resources. Additionally, engaging and mobilizing community participation proved more challenging than anticipated, requiring additional efforts in community outreach and awareness. By implementing these solutions, we aim to overcome the setbacks and ensure the successful execution of the project.

What are the objectives for the next phase or reporting period?

Continue training on Restoration activities, Involving school going children on climate action awareness creation activities. Distribution of planting tools and planting materials

Recommendation to Y's Men International: The Y's Men Club of Common Good Bamenda recommends that Y's Men International continue supporting and expanding the Environmental Restoration for Adaptation Project. 


